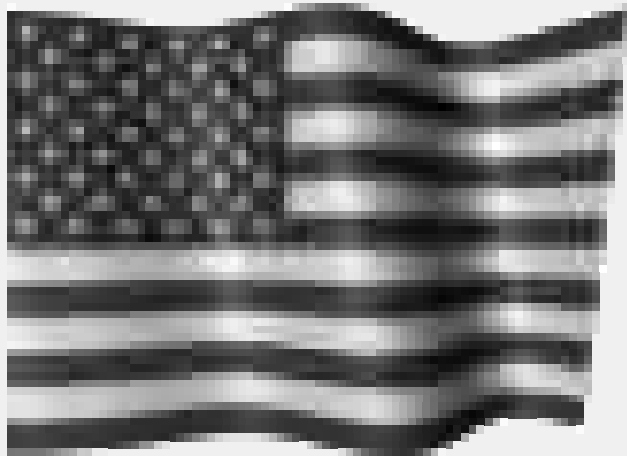

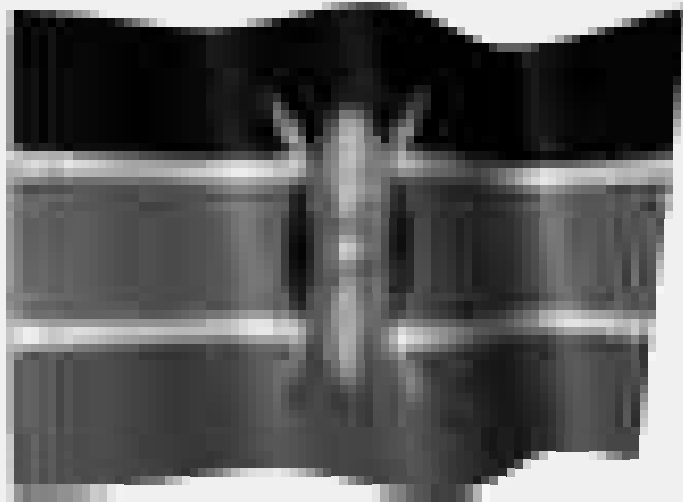

**National absolute poverty has declined from 52.3% in 1997 to 45.9% in 2005/06 but inequality remains high. 1 in 5 Kenyans have consumption levels that are inadequate to meet basic food needs.**

# Kenya

About Kenya Last updated: August 2007

**The economy has been growing steadily over the last three years (4.9% in 2004, 5.8% in 2005 and 6.1% in 2006), but it is not yet sufficient to make rapid progress in reducing poverty.**

About Kenya Last updated: August 2007

**The Government still faces major political and economic challenges including ethnic divisions, weak and corrupt institutions and a run-down infrastructure. A General Election will be held in December 2007.**

About Kenya Last updated: August 2007

**Population of 34.5m.**

**Life expectancy is 45 years.**

**More than 1 in 10 children dies  
before their fifth birthday.**

About Kenya Last updated: August 2007

**Just under 6% of the adult population lives with HIV/AIDS (about 1.3 million people). In the UK the number is around 60,000..**

**1.1 million children in Kenya have been orphaned by AIDS.**

**In total there are 2.4 million orphans in Kenya.**

**Nearly 60% of the population is living on less than \$2 per day.**

**Nearly 60% of the population is living on less than \$2 per day.**



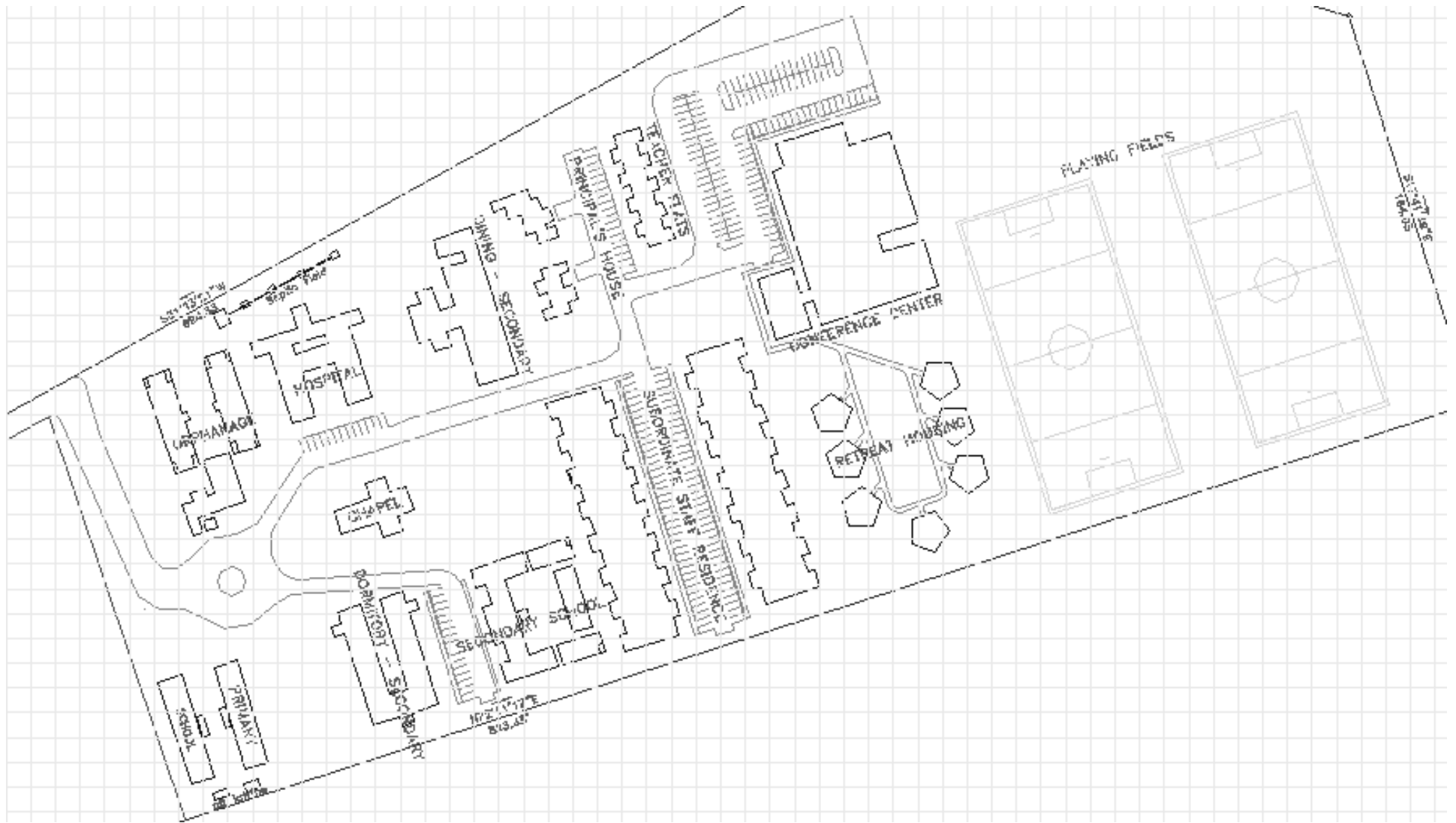
# Nakuru West PCEA, Nakuru Kenya

# Current Status

There are sixty one children currently living at the Bethany Children's home.

There will be housing available for 100 children, January 2008.

# Education is Emphasized

- HIV infection rates are at least twice as high among young people who do not finish primary school as those who do.
- Government schools have a student teacher ration of 90 to 1. Jitegemea schools have a ratio of 35 to 1.

# Education is Emphasized

- **The orphaned children attend school with other children in the community**

# Education is Emphasized

- **In school, the orphaned children are equals to the children who have parents. You cannot tell them apart.**
